I support Bylaw 904 and the proposed rezoning of the affected water areas from Industrial Marine to Aquaculture.

Baynes Sound is one of British Columbia's most productive and environmentally sensitive marine ecosystems. It supports shellfish aquaculture, herring spawning habitat, migratory birds, marine mammals, and numerous fish species that are vital to the ecological and economic health of our region.

Industrial marine activities can pose significant risks to water quality, marine habitat, and the ecological values that make Baynes Sound unique. Where industrial marine uses are no longer authorized under provincial tenure agreements, local zoning should reflect and reinforce the protection of this sensitive marine environment.

Rezoning these areas to Aquaculture is a prudent and responsible step that recognizes the ecological importance of Baynes Sound and helps ensure that future uses are compatible with the long-term health of the ecosystem.
